Ingwaz

This rune is a symbol of the god Frey, god of this world, of embodiment, of the natural. Some seers sit in the diamond form of the Ingwaz. It makes Grith, a safe space, which then allows for Frith, a space so sacred that it is beyond enmity. Frey rises in the spring and opens the heart of the world.

You are here.

You are now. Be here. Be READY to be here. Experience the sacred. Experience one another. Here you will be nourished.

The runes are heathen symbols that are used in divination, talismantic, and chant magic. Hilary Ayer lives to talk about the runes. You may reach her through the Heathen Hospitality Hall.
