Elevator Policy and Tips

- Give priority to hotel staff when they need to use the main elevators. Remember that they are working hard to make your PantheaCon better.
- No more than 8 people in an elevator at once. Large suitcases=1 person.

- No more than 1 power chair, scooter, or walker.

- If you have full mobility, please take the stairs when possible.
